Intent to File a ULP

On 11/16/2010 negotiation on the remodel of bunk rooms was held at Everett with Ops Chief Steil. No agreement was reached at the conclusion of that meeting. Chief Steil said he was going to hold a meeting with the crew and get their opinions. I informed him at that time that that was a by-pass and that all negotiations were to be with me or my duly appointed representative. He decided to instead just discuss it with the Supervisory Captains. On 11/17/2010 a VTC meeting was held with those Captains.

On 11/17/2010 Supervisory Captain Farage held a meeting with his crew to discuss the matter and committed a bypass. On 11/18/2010 Supervisory Captain Tim Nold held a meeting with the crew to discuss this matter and committed a bypass. In those meetings they both told the crew that the plans Chief Steil gave them were finalized and were being done.

Let this serve as official notification of intent to file a ULP for committing a bypass.

Resolution sought:

FLRA training for all supervisors and Union Officers, Supervisory training for all GS-9 Captains, Letter of retraction for the bypass and items stated to the crew at the meeting held 11/18/2010.
