**Opening Remarks:**

The Union chaired the meeting.

**Agenda Items:**

- 1. Reviewed and approved minutes from previous meeting (4 August 2009).**
  
- 2. Union office for IAM&AW – Mr. Gordy Griebel 5/6/08** Mr. Griebel is requesting new space for him since NAVFAC will appoint a Chief Steward and therefore, needs his office. Ms. Birang will follow-up with NAVFAC on whether the Chief Steward will be full-time. Space was discussed at the negotiations table and agreement was reached that the space in Bldg 1101 would be shared by NAVFAC and IAM&AW. **6/3/08** Ms. Birang updated the group that there was no space available in Bldgs 1103 or 1100. Mr. Hanna currently checking with NAVFAC for space in Bldg 1101. Alternative would be Bremerton. Mr. Goddard said that would be OK. Mr. Griebel stated that he has a parking space outside Bldg 943 and he would need a parking space if space would be in a different building. **7/1/08** N13 will meet with NAVFAC XO next week to find office space for either the NAVFAC or CNRNW union steward. Union officials can share space. **9/2/08** N13 still working on it. Steve Markey has the lead. **10/7/08** Mr. Goddard stated that the union needs office space for CNRNW. Originally they were promised space in B1103 where Roland Arper was. NAVFAC has need for both offices in B1101. CNRNW union officials need 2 offices, one at Bremerton and one at Bangor, as stated in the contract. Mr. Campagna said he would take the lead. **11/4/08** Ms. Birang updated group that NAVFAC is looking at Bldg 943 in Bremerton. Mr. Griebel send e-mail to Mr. Markey at NAVFAC about availability of space, parking may be an issue. There are currently 2 parking spaces assigned to N6. There should not be any problems with entry during business hours. Mr. Goddard stated that he would like two offices at Bremerton,

one for the Senior Chief Steward (Mr. Griebel) and one for the Bremerton Chief Steward (Mr. Chavez). Per Mr. Goddard, if NAVFAC can work out the spaces in Bldg 943, issue will be resolved. **12/2/08** Mr. Goddard stated that this issue was not progressing. Mr. Griebel stated that Steve Harvey (PSNS & IMF employee) toured the workspaces last week and stated that he was looking for space in Building 943 also. Mr. Griebel explained to Mr. Harvey that Mr. Markey from NAVFAC was working the space issues for Building 943. Mr. Markle stated that NAVFAC has a Building 943 utilization plan (drawings of the building) already. Mr. Markle will forward document to N13 who will put it on the Gateway and send a link to the Union. **1/6/09** Union did not receive drawings of building 943. ED will call NAVFAC CO for status on space. IAM wants 2 offices in Bremerton. For travel to Bangor, IAM will request reimbursement of mileage. **2/9/09** After recently meeting with the ED on this issue Mr. Goddard stated that he expected to have an answer at this meeting. Mr. Campagna stated that we still did not have an office space identified but that there will be a meeting with the ED on March 11<sup>th</sup> to discuss. Mr. Goddard stated that he arbitration filed on this matter was still pending this action item. Mr. Griebel stated that he wished to be included on discussions of his work assignments if he remains at Bangor. **5/5/09** N13 gave status of the Bangor union office space. On 22 April the Union reviewed/concurred with the space offered in B/1001. Renovations to the space are expected to be completed by 31 July. N00 has ordered furniture, etc. for the new office. N13 discussed Bremerton office space that IAM (CNRNW) is currently sharing with IAM (NAVFAC). IAM agreed that the current arrangement is okay for now until new office space can be located. N13 working with NAVFAC to secure. **8/4/09** N13 reported that the Bangor office space is on track with renovations targeted for completion by 10 October. **1/5/10** N13 reported that the renovation was halted in August before the construction could commence because of an unanticipated brick or mortar material in the wall that required additional funds for removal. NAVFAC has indicated that the additional funding has been requested. Dave Slusher indicated that if we could get the upward obligation number he could help smooth the way for funding. N13 to check with NAVFAC. **Status: Open/N1 action.**

**3. Future attendance at LMPC meetings (HRO).** **1/5/10** Discussions surrounded the cancellation of the last several LMPC meetings due to member's unavailability. IAM & AW stated that with Mike Goddard returning to work and the soon to be appointed Senior Chief they expected they would have a representative at future meetings. N13 will send a meeting reminder asking for meeting confirmation prior to the next meeting. **Status: Closed.**

**4. Use of Government vehicles by Union officials (IAFF).** Taska Elin inquired about the use of government vehicles for her attendance at occasional meetings at Whidbey Island. Mike Goddard stated that he believed that other stewards were getting mileage reimbursement for attendance at meetings at distant locations. He also indicated that Ken Phillips of N1 issues ferry tickets to union representatives when requested. N13, Nancy Lowe will research the current practices for the next meeting. **Status: Open/N13 action.**

**5. 59 minutes of Administrative Leave excludes contact relief personnel (IAFF).**

Taska Elin indicated that some of her members who are contact relief personnel feel slighted when the Admiral sends an all hands e-mail granting 59 minutes of administrative leave for early holiday dismissals, etc. because they are not allowed to take the leave. Taska asked if something could be done to compensate or otherwise acknowledge their dedication and service. N1 Bob Campagna said he would speak to the Executive Director. **Status: Open/N1 action.**
